Lots of shows coming up in the next few months. I'm including showbills for the ones I have. There are some introductory shows coming up also. These shows are usually open shows with some AQHA classes. They are usually one day, smaller, local shows where people can try a few AQHA classes as well as open all-breed classes.

Gordyville March shows — Gordyville tried the 4 judges in 2 days format recently. They had over 2800 entries for the 4 judges. It seems like quite a few people wanted to try the newer format. Quite a few regulars were there, but also some people who haven't been there before or haven't been there recently. Several people did comment that it's harder to keep track of how you did under all 4 judges when the results are being read off. Alyssa Lombardi's horse RL a Sudden Attitude, ridden by Jeff Greaves, picked up some green trail points under 4 judges. Tanya Relander's horse PS Signed in Silver won junior hunter under saddle under all 4 judges. Jim Henrekin's yearling gelding Sensational was reserve champion gelding under one judge. Anne Demirjian's gelding Ima Loping to a Tee did well in open performance geldings and amateur performance geldings, picking up quite a few points. Anne also won novice amateur equitation under 3 judges, novice amateur horsemanship under one judge, and novice amateur showmanship under two judges. Joan Sellberg and Simply a Hustler won 3 of the select amateur horsemanship classes. Brenda Walker & Boston Powers picked up select amateur horsemanship points under 3 judges. Anne Pate & Good Sky Light were second in one select amateur horsemanship class and first in one select amateur showmanship. Luann Meyer & My Details are Hot were first in one select amateur hunter under saddle and picked up some select amateur showmanship and amateur performance mare points. Diane Stewart & One Krymsun Legacy picked up some select amateur hunter under saddle points under all 4 judges. Kathy Harper & Icantakeagoodlook did well in select amateur western pleasure and novice amateur showmanship, picking up points under all 4 judges. Debbie Wagner & Ima Chipped Jewell picked up some select amateur showmanship points. Beth Manion & Dont BSB Me won a select amateur hunter under saddle under one judge. Lauren Stepaniak & Native Iron picked up some amateur trail points. Alyssa Lombardi & RL a Sudden Attitude and Keegan Fisher & Don't Pass Him picked up some youth horsemanship points. Alyssa also won youth equitation under three judges. Keegan also picked up novice youth trail and youth western pleasure points. Alexandria Albright & her new horse A Fluid Intimidation picked up some novice youth horsemanship and novice youth western pleasure points. Alexis Fisher & PQH Good N Flashy were second in novice youth western pleasure

under one judge and first under another judge. Kristine Stewart & SF Banker, Kaitlyn Dudding & Truly That Simple, Cora Rogalski & Zippin in Harmony, Alexis Fisher & PQH Good N Flashy and Ashley Wegeng & MWS Private Zips picked up points in a large novice youth showmanship class. Kristine Stewart & SF Banker also did well in novice youth western pleasure and 13 & under western pleasure, picking up points in both. Kaitlyn Dudding's horse Truly That Simple has been doing well in youth halter, picking up some youth grand championships. Cori Flowers and Goodbar-shandsumasset won youth trail and 14-18 showmanship under one judge and also picked up some youth equitation points.

Take care of your vaccinations in the spring.

As spring rolls around, horse-owners should begin thinking about vaccinations and annual veterinary check-ups. With the arrival of spring, it's time to vaccinate our horses and it's also a good time to have your veterinarian give them their annual check-up.

The American Association of Equine Practitioners, an AQHA educational alliance partner, revised their vaccination recommendations in 2008, adding both **West Nile virus** and rabies to the "core" vaccination recommendations. They join tetanus and Eastern and Western equine encephalomyelitis (sleeping sickness) on the core list.

The AQHA Official Handbook of Rules and Regulations is now available at the touch of a button.

At the 2011 AQHA Convention, AQHA announced the release of a digital version of the AQHA Official Handbook. The AQHA 2011 Rules digital tool is available through iTunes to download to the iPhone, iPad, iPod touch or Android, and is free for everyone.

The digital handbook is a useful tool for any AQHA member. For instance, if you are at a show and forget your AQHA Handbook, all the information you need is on your device. You'll find everything from proper attire to reining patterns, registration requirements, color and marking definitions, and more. AQHA will soon add

additional features, with the possibility of including access to records, show dates and other important AQHA announcements.

Equine Piroplasmiasis

A negative equine piroplasmiasis test is now required at AQHA World Shows.

As of July 1, a negative equine piroplasmiasis test will be required to show at AQHA World Shows. Beginning July 1, 2011, all horses entering the grounds for any AQHA world championship show – in Oklahoma City, Amarillo or Houston – will be required to present a certificate of a negative blood test for equine piroplasmiasis. The tests must have been completed within the previous six months.

Equine piroplasmiasis is a disease of horses, donkeys, mules and zebras that is caused by two parasitic organisms, *Theileria equi* and *Babesia caballi*. Although, equine piroplasmiasis is primarily transmitted to horses by ticks, this bloodborne disease has been spread mechanically from animal to animal by contaminated needles.

Currently, racetracks in 11 states have testing requirements for equine piroplasmiasis and that number will increase. With the potential of an infected racehorse retiring to the show pen, the show industry is vulnerable. "As the industry leader, AQHA needs to be vigilant and establish testing requirements to ensure any case of equine piroplasmiasis can't be traced back to an AQHA event," said Tom Persechino, AQHA executive director of competition and breed integrity. "We're encouraging all exhibitors to contact their veterinarians to schedule these tests. If the tests are completed around the second week of July, that horse will be eligible to show at the youth, select and open/amateur world without requiring another test." AQHA believes that requiring a negative test at its world shows is prudent and responsible. Currently, horses should be tested for both organisms. "These are inexpensive tests that we don't believe will burden our members," Persechino said.

AQHA is recommending the following rule: **AQHA World Show Recommendations for EP Testing: Effective July 1, 2011, no horse shall be allowed entry onto a World Show venue without verification that required testing for equine piroplasmiasis has been completed. All horses seeking entry onto an AQHA World Show venue must be accompanied with a certificate demonstrating the horse(s) has been tested for piroplasmiasis by a C-ELISA assay for both *Theileria equi* and *Babesia caballi* and reported to be negative. The testing shall be performed and the results reported by a laboratory certified and approved by the USDA to conduct the testing and shall be completed on a blood sample collected from the horse during the six month period preceding the animal's entry onto the grounds.**
