## **NOVICE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS**

**Learn the three ways to qualify for the inaugural AQHA Novice championship shows.** (By Megan Brincks for America's Horse Daily)

Competitors can qualify for AQHA's Novice championship shows three different ways. It's nice to be Novice, especially now that AQHA is offering championship-level shows for this division. The AQHA Novice program is available to youth and amateur competitors who have earned fewer than 25 points in the class they are competing in.

The inaugural SmartPak AQHA Western Novice Championship Show in Las Vegas and the Nutrena AQHA Eastern Novice Championship Show in Murfreesboro, Tennessee, will be held October 5-7.

Want to know how to get there? Three Ways to Qualify for a Novice Championship Show

1. Competitors can qualify by placing in the top 10 at an AQHA regional championship show in a Novice class.
2. Showing at 20 AQHA shows during the qualifying period will complete eligibility. For this option, there is no requirement about where the rider competes geographically.
3. Competitors can qualify through their state or provincial affiliate. For this option, competitors should become familiar with their affiliate's rules because they vary state to state. State qualification information can be found on the Illinois Quarter Horse Assn. website.

The national qualifying period for the 2012 championships is May 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. If a competitor graduated out of a Novice class during 2011, he or she is still eligible to compete at the 2012 Novice championship shows.

### **The Fuss about Drivers' Licenses: enforcement has been stepped up all across the country - safety cited.**

Federal rules governing the operation of vehicles weighing over 10,001 lbs., which are used in "commerce," are frequently misunderstood or not well known by many in the horse industry. They can be as complex as the tax code, and it appears enforcement has been stepped up nationwide. Violations get expensive in a hurry. As most horses are hauled in combination vehicles (trucks w/ trailers) that are rated, or weigh, over 10,001# GCVW, these rules may apply to you. To find out the weight rating on your vehicles, look for the manufacturer's statement. It's a sticker located on the driver's side door of your truck and usually visible on the outside of your trailer. Add the two GVWR numbers together to determine your GCVW. If the GCVW of your outfit is over 26,001# additional rules may apply.

Hauling for commercial purposes basically means anytime you intend to make a buck. You'll probably be considered to be hauling in "commerce" if:

- You haul horses for payment or receive anything of value
- You haul horses to advertised events that offer prize money
- Your vehicle is registered in your farm or company's name or advertises your business or sponsors

If you qualify as hauling in commerce and your GCVW is over 10,001# you will need to apply to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration for a medical card, USDOT number, UCR registration, and you may need to keep an "hours of service" log when driving. More information can be found at [www.fmcsa.dot.gov](http://www.fmcsa.dot.gov). As with most regulations there are exemptions that may apply. If you haul solely for "recreational purposes" these rules won't apply as they are generally waived for recreational vehicle operators. If you race or show for prize money they probably do.

## General Guidelines and Tips for Sharing the Trail (Shared From: American Trails, Inc.)

- Make sure your horse has the temperament and training for riding on congested public trails. Busy multi-use trails are not the proper place for schooling green horses. Remove your horse from the trail if you begin experiencing behavior problems.
- Obey posted speed/gait limits and use common sense in crowded areas. Cantering/galloping on crowded trails endangers everyone. Move to the right to allow faster trail users to pass.
- Announce your intentions to pass other trail users and reduce speed in order to pass safely. Pass on the left only.
- As a courtesy to others in your group, use appropriate hand signals for turning, slowing, etc., and give verbal warning for dangers on the trail (e.g. holes, low branches).
- Remember that other trail users may not be familiar with horses or their reactions to new experiences. Your horse may be another trail users introduction to horses, what you do is a reflection of the local horse community. Cheerfully answer questions about your horse. You are an ambassador for the entire equestrian community.
- Do not clean out your trailer in the parking area.
