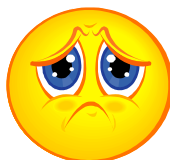

Leased horses may be shown by a novice amateur or novice youth in the novice division only. The lease must be at least a 6 month lease and on file with AQHA at the time of the show.

The novice skill sets have changed again for this year. If you haven't updated your novice card, get the information from the AQHA website or call AQHA to get your novice card updated. Each class is a skill set this year!

There are several new "green" classes this year for entry level horses showing in their first year in the class or those who have not earned 10 points in the category. The green classes are stepping stones to the more advanced level of competition with seasoned horses. You may see green western pleasure, green hunter under saddle and green trail at some of nearby shows this year.

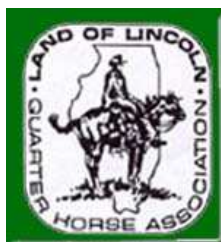

South on I-294 to I-88 West to Aurora; Exit Orchard Rd.; South on Orchard to Illinois; right (west) on Illinois and take 1st right into Orchard Valley Golf Course entrance--restaurant is in the Clubhouse.

From Southeast:

North on I-294 to I-88 West to Aurora; Exit at Orchard Rd. South on Orchard to Illinois; turn right (or west) on Illinois and take the first right into Orchard Valley Golf Course---restaurant is in the Clubhouse.

From West:

I-88 East to Orchard Rd. exit; South on Orchard to Illinois; right (west) on Illinois to 1st right into Orchard Valley Golf Course entrance---restaurant is in the Clubhouse.

From Southwest or South:

Orchard Rd. extends South to Rt. 71 or Rt. 34; both of these roads cross Rt. 47; You can come up Rt. 47 to either of these roads and then come East to Orchard, or continue North on Rt. 47 to Galena Blvd. Then East on Galena to Orchard; North on Orchard to Illinois; left (west) on Illinois to 1st right into Orchard Valley Golf Course entrance--restaurant is in the Clubhouse. *Note. There are 2 roads named Galena in area; both Cross Rt. 47 in Yorkville/Sugar Grove area. 1st one is just North on Rt. 47 & Rt. 34, while the other is farther North a couple of miles; Most direct would be Northern one, but both get you to Orchard Rd.

From Northwest:

South on Rt. 47 to Galena Blvd. in Sugar Grove; turn left (or east) on Galena Blvd. There is a light at 47 & Galena. Go east to Orchard Rd.; left (North) on Orchard to next light (Illinois); left on Illinois to 1st right into Orchard Valley Golf Course entrance--restaurant is in the Clubhouse;

Guidelines for Illinois Livestock Premises Registration Requirement for 2008 Exhibition



The Illinois Livestock Premises Registration System is part of the National Animal Identification System (NAIS), which is a state/federal industry cooperative program intended to identify animal premises, individual animals, and ultimately to track movement of animals in commerce.

The program is being developed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) and State agencies, in cooperation with industry, to enable 48-hour trace back of the movements of an diseased or exposed animal. This will help to ensure rapid disease containment and maximum protection of America's animals.

The first step in developing the comprehensive national system will be to assign a unique number, a Premises ID number, to every location where animals are born, managed, marketed, or exhibited. Veterinary clinics involved in food animal practice will also be assigned a Premises ID number.

Whether you agree with the concept or not, you must have an ID number in order to show at a county or state fair in 2008. The Premises ID number should be obtained prior to making fair entries and placed on the entry form. The ID number relates only to the location of the animal and not ownership. If your horse is housed on someone else's property, that property must have an ID number.

Premises registration is free and can be performed online at www.agr.state.il.us/premiseid or by calling 1-866-299-9256 for a paper form. A printable postage paid registration form is also available at the website. When registering online, you will be immediately issued the Premises ID number. When mailing in a paper form, you may need to allow 3-4 weeks to be issued a number.

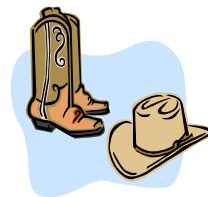

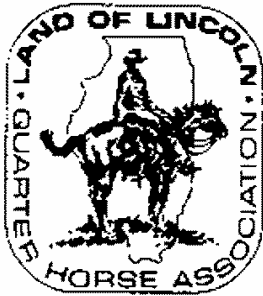
