The Barnes family of Northbrook, Illinois, said good-bye to its longtime equine family member, **Zippos Ace Of Spades**, on Friday, February 5. "Ace," a two-time AQHA World Championship Show all-around amateur horse, was euthanized due to complications from laminitis.

Patti Novakowski and Certain Luke have been notified by AQHA that they are in the top ten nationally for Select Hunter Under Saddle. Patti was surprised to get the note—she had no idea!

Chayna DeNicolo, an AQHYA, LLQHA and IQHA member, has started a Facebook page for young riders called : "Hoofbeats and Heartbeats" that is dedicated to youth regardless of what discipline/breed they ride. This page reaches out to riders that have suffered equine related injuries from a first time fall off to broken bones— or those who've had a horse suffer/receive an unhealable injury and have to be put down— or riders who just want to share memories of a special horse that touched their heart. Chayna was inspired to make this group as it is the worst feeling in the world to be alone, and people with common interests/experiences are never alone. Chayna faced two very difficult challenges last year when first her show horse and best friend Bruno was diagnosed with an incurable navicular bone fracture and within a week of getting that news she was kicked in the face by a young horse incurring near fatal injuries requiring 12 titanium plates and 6 screws in her head. Both incidents left Chayna in her own words "physically, mentally, and emotionally scarred" and encouraged her to turn her negative experiences into a positive by reaching out to others in the equine community she loves. The site is open to all and has over 1000 members at this time.

Enjoy a celebration of the design, style and grace of the western saddle at the American Quarter Horse Hall of Fame & Museum.

The western saddle is one of the great executions of form and function merging into a third greater thing -- art. Its design is built around use, lightness, durability and fit to give the rider the ability to stay on board while



at the same time not getting in the way of the horse, all the while being able to hold an 800-pound steer by only a rope wound around the saddle horn.

BOARD MEETING

January 8, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:17 p.m. on the south side. Present were: Cheryl LaMaster, LeaAnn Koch, Ed Lawrence, Luann Meyer, Rich Smith, Valerie Doubrawa, and Bob Lee. Minutes from the previous meeting were approved. A treasurer's report was presented and approved as presented. The checking account has \$5300 in it; the savings account has a balance of \$19400.

SHOWS: The Sept. shows made a profit of \$1154, which is down from past year. Entries at these shows have declined over the past couple of years. Illinois QHA has a conflict with its 2010 futurity dates. The dates they have with the state fairground are actually LLQHA's weekend with AQHA. The fairground does not have the other weekend available for IQHA. Simply exchanging dates with IQHA does not work since the other weekend is not available at Gordyville. We are working with Mary Hannagan to find alternate dates for the Sept. shows. The Run to the Border shows are progressing with some of the judges already hired. Wisconsin approval has been sought but will not occur. The informal word was that they did not want to approve our date since it conflicts with a date already approved for that weekend. A special event on the Wednesday before the show weekend is being requested. Showmanship and trail will be the events.

Some changes in show rules applying to select and amateurs were discussed at the meeting. When those classes are less than 3 people, the classes will be combined. Show management no longer will request approval from the participants—they will automatically be combined. Changes in performance halter qualification were also discussed. A performance ROM in any division will make the horse eligible to compete in all divisions of performance halter. An ROM in showmanship (earned in 2010 or beyond) does not qualify the horse for a performance ROM. A maximum of 5 points in showmanship can be used towards the performance ROM. Horses who have already earned a performance ROM are not affected. Participants in the classes mentioned above are encouraged to check the AQHA rulebook regarding the changes—and stay informed.

NOMINATIONS: Nominations were taken for directors and officers. Cheryl agreed to contact those not present to see if they wished to run.

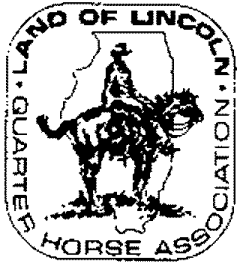
