Managing Horses During Drought

Abnormally dry conditions pose unique health care and management challenges for horse owners.

Pasture Horses on productive pastures tend to exercise naturally as they graze; this constant moving and foraging is beneficial for their digestive health. When green pasture dwindles, however, horses tend to exercise less and instead wait in the shade for feeding time.

These horses are more inclined to have gastrointestinal problems that can lead to colic. Thus, under these conditions I recommend feeding horses a generous amount of a bland (such as long-stem) grass hay to keep them eating and occupied during the day. This is preferable to having them wait around for an occasional rich feeding. When moisture finally returns, it is important to moderate horses' access to rapidly changing pasture, so their systems can readjust to green grass.

Hay Drought conditions also reduce hay supplies, making it difficult for owners to maintain consistent hay diets for their horses. Radically changing feed types increase a horse's risk for health problems, especially colic. If you can't maintain a consistent hay type, source, and quality, gradually reduce the amount of the old batch you feed, mixing it with an increasing amount of the new hay (over three to five days) to ease the transition. When purchasing hay from a new source, always examine it carefully for mold, dust, weeds, blister beetles, and sharp seed awns. While feed concentrates can supplement horses' diets in some cases, they should not replace hay (high fiber or roughage feeds). Hay should be the staple of the equine diet.

Toxic Plants Horses with adequate forage usually avoid eating toxic weeds. During drought conditions, however, when weeds might be the only green plants on pasture, horses are more likely to eat them. The best way to prevent this is to provide more consistent access to good-quality hay. Talk to your vet or local equine extension agent about the toxic plants in your area. You should learn to recognize these and, if possible, remove them from pastures.

Championship-Style

AQHA is excited to welcome more than 4,000 entries to the inaugural AQHA Novice Championships, October 4-7, 2012. The SmartPak AQHA West Novice Championship Show will be held in Las Vegas, while the Nutrena AQHA East Novice Championship Show will be held in Murfreesboro, Tennessee. Competitors qualified nationally or through affiliate qualifying methods. Methods of affiliate qualifying varied by affiliate, and the AQHA Affiliate Council helped to coordinate with the state and provincial affiliates to determine the method of affiliate qualifying.

Two national invitation opportunities also existed for competitors. Those include a top-10 placing at an AQHA Regional Championship show in a Novice class or showing at 20 AQHA shows throughout the year. For this latter option, competitors may show around the nation – there is no regional preference or requirement.

The national qualifying period for this year's Novice Championships was May 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. Competitors' invitations were not specific to the event in which they qualified; competitors were able to enter all classes at the Novice Championships for which they are Novice eligible.

Not only will competitors be vying for the title of the very first Novice champion, but AQHA is also offering up a herd of other awards. At the show, awards will be given for all-around, high-point, halter Champion of Champions and high-point Rookie.

A new award, the AQHA Road Warrior trophy, will be handed out, as well. This award will go to the high-point Novice youth and Novice amateur who competed in either the Scottsdale Classic in Arizona and then the SmartPak West Novice Championship, or the Nutrena East Novice Championship and then the All American Quarter Horse Congress in Ohio.

If you'd like to qualify for the 2013 Novice Championships, the qualifying period kicked off on May 1, 2012, and it will wrap up on June 30, 2013.

Millie Mauritzson of Port Byron, Illinois, grew up showing horses. When she was 18, she had to put aside the hobby ... for nearly 40 years. But when she sold her successful tax/investment company and retired, she was ready to get back into it.

She was showing part time when, six years ago, she decided to go big. Her partner was the 2002 gelding Chex Your Destiny, a sorrel son of Zippo Pine Chex. The two have been very successful. Their accomplishments include amateur Superiors in horsemanship, trail and western pleasure, as well as an open Superior in trail. Despite the 6.5 hour drive one way to get to St. Paul, Minnesota, Millie has attended the AQHA Regional Three Championship the past five years, and has earned three buckles. "I just love it," she says of the show. "It's a mini World Show. (Great) people, a fun show, and not as much pressure." She chose "Scooby," she says, because of his impeccable temperament. "I needed a completely quiet horse," she says. "He is a sweetheart. His personality is just tops. I've never had one like him. He doesn't need hardly any warmup - 15 minutes and he's ready to show."

Millie is supported in her efforts by her husband of 50 years, Bruce. She is considering attending the Adequan Select World Championship Show - especially now that the Super-Select award is available. "Showing has always been my dream, if I could show Congress or the World," she says. "We've gone way beyond my dream, what he's accomplished in six years. I hope we've got a few years yet."

Run From the Border Shows

This year we moved the June Run to the Border shows from the Ledges facility in the Rockford area to Gordyville. The June dates didn't seem to be working too well and we couldn't find another date at that facility. Shows that had been on the July weekend were combined with the Run to the Border shows; the name was changed slightly; and plans were going well, we thought. Just before the shows the heat had been intense, but the show management also experienced "heat" of a different kind. Questions and comments started to pop up on Facebook about the show numbers. Some comments were even made days before the shows that the shows were being cancelled. I had never experienced such a devastating effect on a show circuit before. As little as 2 days prior to the show we still had over 60 stall reservations but the cancellations kept coming in. Some people who pulled into the shows turned around and left. What happened was sad—sad for the 2 associations, LLQHA and IQHA, that put on the shows. We held the first 2 days of shows with very small numbers, working with the exhibitors present to hold classes that would have points. Regrettably, after several conversations with AQHA, we decided to cancel the weekend shows. We called the 3 judges, explained the situation and worked with them to try to schedule them for future shows. We worked with AQHA to move 2 of the 3 shows to future weekends in order to not lose future priority on those show dates.

I understand that people have to make decisions about which shows to attend. Many factors go into that decision. I understand the exhibitor side, but I also am on the show management side throughout the year. Without support for shows in Illinois there won't be shows in Illinois. At this point we don't know what the plans are for next year for those shows, but they won't be on that same July weekend, for sure.

The AQHA Executive Committee approves equipment rules that are effective at the 2012 AQHA World Championship Show.

A dedication to putting the American Quarter Horse first has led the AQHA Executive Committee to make changes in AQHA rules as far as equipment use at all AQHA-approved shows and approve a structure of fines and penalties that will be assessed to violators of these rules. All of these changes are based on recommendations from the AQHA Animal Welfare Commission, which was appointed earlier this year by the Executive Committee to ensure the welfare of the American Quarter Horse. The Executive Committee also approved the Animal Welfare Commission's definition of abuse: Any excessive and/or repetitive action to cause obvious distress or discomfort to a horse. By November 2012 and to coincide with the 2012 AQHA World Championship Show, new equipment policies will be in place. The policies are published on AQHA's website, and exhibitors, owners and trainers have until November 1 to ask questions and become familiar with the policies.

Beginning with the 2012 AQHA World Championship Show in November, the following training equipment, in addition to that listed in the AQHA rulebook, will not be allowed at any AQHA shows:

1. Prohibited training equipment at all AQHA shows include riding in a curb bit without a curb strap, wire or solid metal curb straps no matter how padded; wire cavessons; wire or cable tie-downs; bumper bits; metal bosals, no matter how padded; chambons; headstalls made of metal (even if encased in a protective material); twisted rawhide; or rope (3/8-inch rope may be used with a slip (gag) bit with a smooth mouth piece only); running martingales with curb bits; or draw reins attached between or around the front legs.
2. No one is allowed to ride a horse with a curb bit without a properly adjusted, approved curb strap or curb chain.
3. A running martingale may be used with a snaffle bit only.

Congratulations to LeaAnn Koch on selling her great halter filly, Best to Be Me. She's been busy raising replacements and recently attended the Sept. Iowa futurity shows with young babies. Congratulations to Millie Mauritzson and Chex Your Destiny for placing 7th in trail at the Select World Show. She was 1st in the super select category for that trail class also. She was 2nd in the super select category in her horsemanship class.

Get well soon to Bruce Mauritzson and Alyssa Christensen. Both have been in the hospital recently.
